In observance of Memorial Day, Bartow Baptist Association will be closed Monday, May 31.

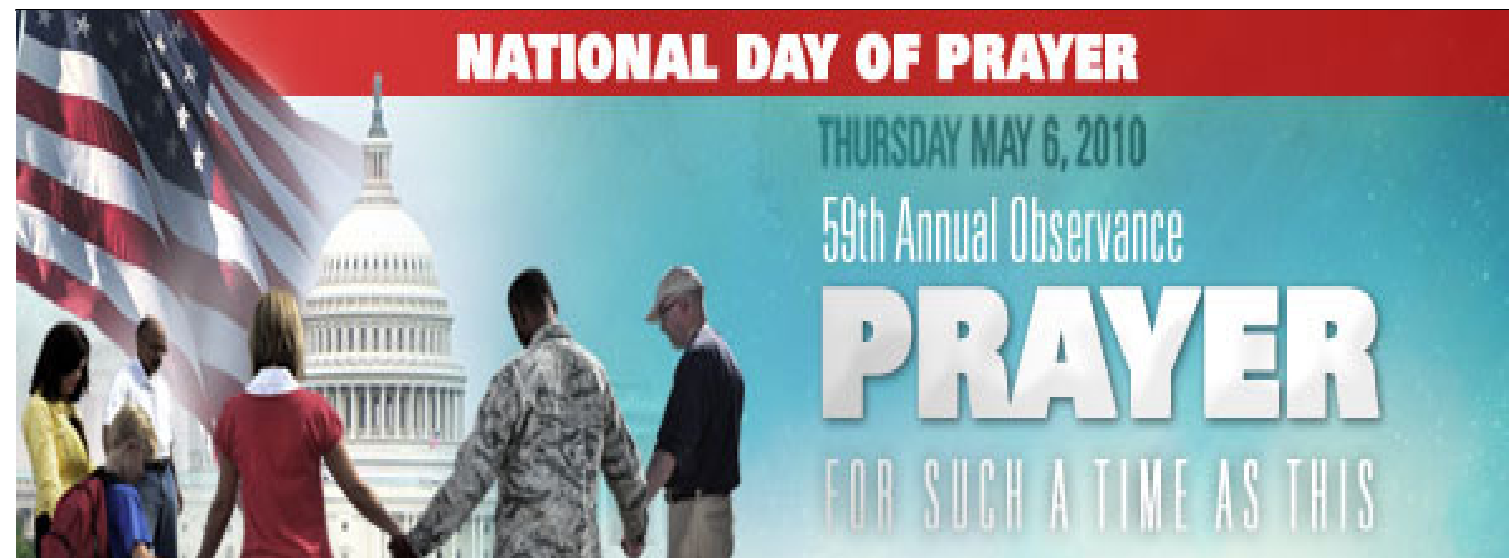

## A word from your Associational Missionary:

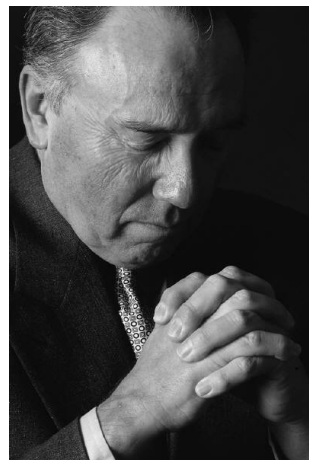

## Leadership Summit

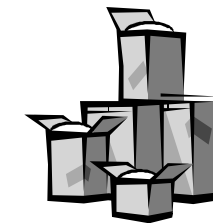
**Monday, July 12 and Tuesday, July 13**
